Any Wyoming 4-H member or screened leader can participate in 4-H educational camps and conferences (Note: Age restrictions).

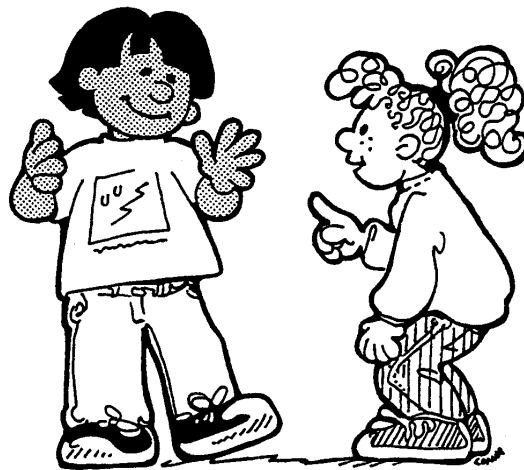
